The dress reveals a deep purple. The nose is expressive, with very ripe red fruits. The mouth is ample, powerful and intense, more than 20 caudalies. The tannins are smooth and powerful. A high-class wine voted best wine of the graves and Pessac-Léognan by the magazine Revue des Vins de France.
